RESOLUTION 2023-1

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF EASTON PARK COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT DECLARING A VACANCY IN SEAT 4 ON THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS PURSUANT TO SECTION 190.006(3)(b), FLORIDA STATUTES; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, CONFLICTS AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, Easton Park Community Development District (the "<u>District</u>") is a local unit of special purpose government created and existing pursuant to Chapter 190, Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, on November 8, 2022, two (2) members of the Board of Supervisors (the "<u>Board</u>") were to be elected by the Qualified Electors of the District, as that term is defined in Section 190.003, Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Florida law, there was a qualifying period for candidates intending to run for the seats on the Board up for election; and

WHEREAS, at the close of the qualifying period no Qualified Elector qualified to run for one of the two (2) seats available for election by the Qualified Electors of the District; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 190.006(3)(b), Florida Statutes, the Board shall declare such unfilled seat as vacant, effective the second Tuesday following the general election; and

WHEREAS, a Qualified Elector is to be appointed to the vacant seat within ninety (90) days thereafter; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds that it is in the best interests of the District to adopt this Resolution declaring the seat that was available for election as vacant as of November 22, 2022.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF EASTON PARK COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. DECLARATION OF VACANCY. The following seat is hereby declared vacant effective as of November 22, 2022:

Seat 4 (currently vacant)

SECTION 2. APPOINTMENT/INCUMBENT. Pursuant to Section 190.006(3)(b), Florida Statutes the Board shall appoint a Qualified Elector to fill each vacancy stated in Section 1 on or before February 20, 2023. Until such time as the Board nominates a Qualified Elector to fill the vacancy declared in Section 1 above, the incumbent Board member in the seat shall remain in office.

SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY. If any section or part of a section of this Resolution be declared invalid or unconstitutional, the validity, force and effect of any other section or part of a section of this Resolution shall not thereby be affected or impaired unless it clearly appears that such other section or part of a section of this Resolution is wholly or necessarily dependent upon the section or part of a section so held to be invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 4. CONFLICTS. All resolutions or parts thereof in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, superseded and repealed.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Resolution shall become effective upon its adoption.

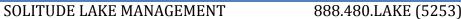

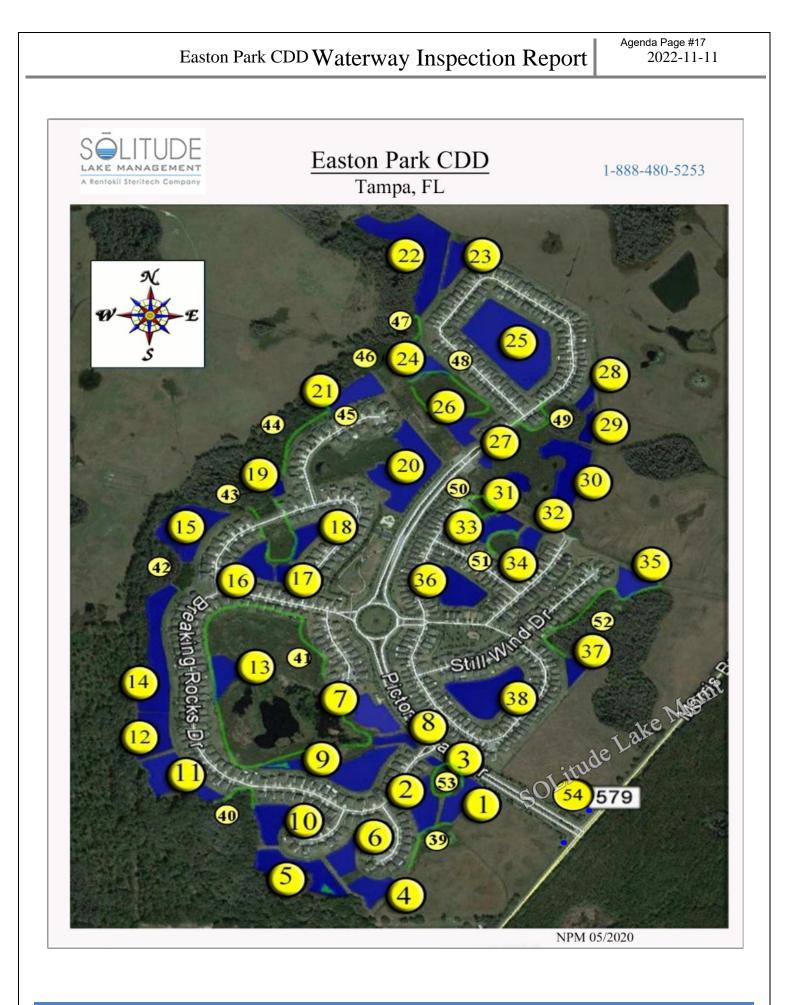


Management Summary
